Posting started April 22nd. All scores, 9 and 18 hole, league and casual play, must be posted. All rounds played at CCC must be posted within 24 hours or the Committee will post a penalty score of even par for you.

Your Grounds Crew welcomes everyone back for another great season here at Caledonia CC. The course has wintered quite well despite the long, cold winter. Ernie and his crew have done a great job getting the course cleaned up and are well ahead of schedule for this time of the year.

As you can see, the crew has been making many improvements to the course this spring and will be continuing them into the summer and fall months.

Please excuse our dust while we are making the course better. The crew is going to be converting the tees over to bent grass at the beginning of the golf season. They also have started to do some tree work by removing diseased and nuisance trees.

Bunkers are also to be addressed this season by edging, installing drainage and in some cases renovating by reshaping and adding sand. An AG plan has been drawn up for the season to improve the overall condition of the course, by focusing on the green, tees, and fairways.

If there are any questions or comments please talk to Bob or Al and they will be more than happy to discuss this with you.

One of the changes this year is the 90 degree rule for crossing the fairways, the more we keep the carts in the rough the faster we are going to get our fairways in shape.
